CLL

- Glossaries and Dictionaries on Space key words.
- Non-Fiction – Recount newspaper report writing on the first Moon landing – interview questions for the astronauts.
- Stories set in imaginary space worlds.
- Universal addresses and postcards sent from outer space.

- Data Handling – facts, figures and dimensions of the planets within our solar system: *organise, present, analyse and interpret the data in tables, diagrams, tally charts, pictograms and bar charts, using ICT where appropriate.*
- Counting and partitioning number – Unit A1
- Securing number facts understanding shape Unit B1.

PSED

- Creation Stories – what do creation Stories teach us about the world?
- What part do believers say God played in creation?
- SEAL: New Beginnings – creating a community.

CD

- Space fabric pictures – tie dyed background .

- Research of Space facts using the internet and Science websites.
- Papier mache planet Earth.
- Solar System mobiles.
- Water propelled rockets and rockets propelled in alternative ways.
- French – revision on colours, numbers, days, months, animals, classroom equipment plus basic introductions.
