Dear Parents/Carers,

WOULD YOUR CHILD LIKE TO ATTEND CRAFT CLUB?...

At Olveston School, we are always on the lookout for new and interesting ways for children to enjoy their breaktimes and with this in mind we have decided to introduce a 'Craft Circle'.

The Craft Circle will be available to 2 groups of 10 children in the playground (weather permitting) on a Wednesday lunchtime. The groups will be supervised and assisted by trained Year 6 children who are always eager for responsibility!

If your child would like to take part, please complete the form below and return to the office by Friday 12th December 2008. Based on the number of responses, a rota of children will be in place to ensure that every child wishing to participate has an opportunity to do so.

The resources available to children will include paper/card, pens, scissors, gluesticks, fabrics, beads and other embellishments.

One group of 10 children will be able to use their own ideas to create their own personal artwork.

To the second group of 10 children, we would like to offer a *specific* craft project. This is where we would like your help, if you are able to offer it! We would like to hear from you if you are able to lend an occasional hand with craft preparation in your own time. (N.B. Some of you will have already received this letter; thank you for your responses).

Obviously, the more parents we can recruit on our craft preparation rota the less frequent the preparation will be; e.g. if 10 parents are willing to prepare a craft, the preparation we would ask you to do would only be once every 10 weeks. The craft idea is entirely up to you and could be something really simple like leaf / brass rubbing or tying three pieces of wool together for plaiting, so please don't think you need to be a super creative whizz to help! All we would ask for is ...

1. A craft idea that would appeal to both boys and girls.
2. Some simple guidelines for the Year 6 children.
3. Enough 'components' for 10 children.

If you are able to help, please could you complete the relevant section of the form below (we will then be in touch to let you know when we would like you to provide your craft).

Finally, if you have any craft items that you would be willing to donate to craft club, we would be more than grateful to receive them. This could be anything from stickers to wool, felt tips, paper, ribbon or indeed anything you have lying around that you no longer have use for. In addition, we require transparent storage tubs with lids (the Chinese takeaway ones are ideal!), also gratefully received.
