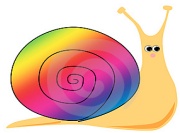
Olveston CEVC Primary School Creative Curriculum Term Overview

CD= Creative Development

CLL

- Non-fiction report writing. Create an information booklet about endangered animals. (This will include the use of contents pages, index and glossaries). (Linked with ITC)
- Narrative – fables – looking at animal stories with a moral (hare/tortoise). Chn write own fable.
 - Non-fiction – recount. Chn will write a recount of their trip to the zoo.



MD

- Counting and partitioning number – Unit A1
- Securing number facts understanding shape Unit B1
- Using zoo map – chn investigate area and compass points (movement and direction)
- Data collection (linked with ITC) chn make tally charts and bar graphs about animals.

PSED

- SEAL – New beginnings
- Feeling welcomed/unwelcome.
- Understanding our rights and responsibilities.
- Being special – knowing what we are good at and celebrating success – create class book.

Theme Changes!

CD

- Self/family portraits. (linked to PSED).
- Plant collage picture, chn use different textures to create own plant for display.
- 4 seasons – chn re-create the same nature scene but throughout the different seasons (noting the changes in plant/animal life).
- Role-play area – garden centre – chn help create props.

KUW

- ITC – create databases using animal info. Internet research for reports.
- Sc – looking at human, plant and animal life cycles. Looking at how animals/plant adapt to their environment.
- Geo – use map to identify different countries/landscape where plants/animals live (linked with sc)..
 - MFL- animals and numbers in French
- Visit to Bristol Zoo, focus on animal/plant life cycles.

PD

- The eagle and the fish dance – learning to use story as a stimulus for dance (Val Sabin)
- Ball control – chn develop ball control skills such as rolling, bowling, throwing, catching a ball.
