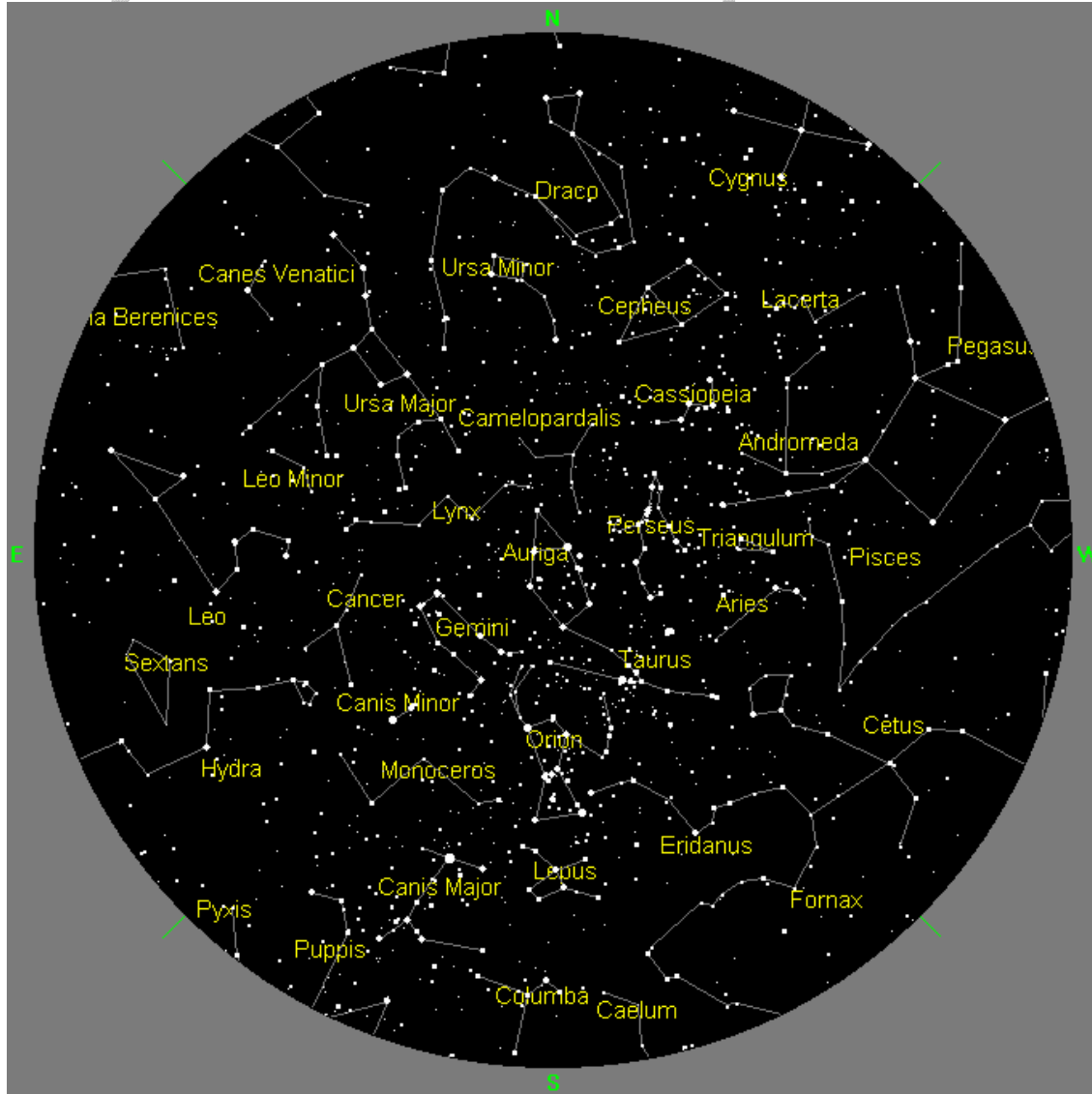


## Are you the Star Gazer Champ of team Four?

- ❖ You can spot constellations without telescopes or binoculars so do not worry if you do not own any!
- ❖ You may find it easier to look at the stars in a remote area (away from light pollution!)
- ❖ You may wish to create a spreadsheet/pie chart/ graph showing the data that you have collected over the three weeks.
- ❖ You may wish to use ICT to record information or pencil, pens and paper. Perhaps you will make a Star-Gazers Diary to share with the class!
- ❖ Perhaps you will share your wonderful art skills with us and create a constellation map showing all that you have spotted!
