Dear Parents/Carers

The children are now very excited about our camp in June (as am I). Outlined below are the final details and information.

Children should **arrive at school no earlier than 9.30 am on Monday.** We will be leaving school for Whitemead at 11.45 am, therefore children will need a packed lunch in a disposable bag with no fizzy drinks. We will eat this once we arrive at the site. **We will arrive back at school at 2.00 pm on Friday** and ask that you are here to collect your child/children as they will be very tired!

All of the activities for the children are outside, therefore it is essential that the children bring a waterproof coat and a number of trousers and jumpers. Please pack a couple of sets of very old clothes as the children are likely to get extremely muddy! We are hoping to have a swimming session during the week, so please pack a swimming costume/trunks and swimming towel. Your child must also bring a towel, pillow and sleeping bag. Please see the separate Kit List for more details.

Just a reminder that no electrical equipment or mobile phones are allowed but children may bring a camera. We discourage children bringing expensive cameras, disposable cameras are an excellent choice.

Any medicines need to be clearly labeled and handed to Mrs Bendall on the morning of departure with a completed Medical Form – these are available from the School Office. Pocket money of £5.00 should be in a named purse/wallet/money bag and handed to Mrs King on the morning of departure.

I will be in daily contact with Miss Bertham so any queries or concerns that you might have while we are away can be discussed via the School Office.
